

Provisional paratransit eligibility (6 months)

Extract of the *Paratransit eligibility policy*

« Provisional eligibility for a maximum of 6 months may be granted exceptionally to an applicant who must undergo, in support of his application, an evaluation of his disability by a professional in the network and, if applicable, of his potential for learning to use public transportation. As soon as the committee receives the evaluation results, the applicant will be granted a general, provisional, seasonal or partial eligibility, which may be provisional eligibility for a maximum of 18 months, or refused eligibility altogether. »

Important

If you think that you will still need the paratransit services beyond the 6-month period of your provisional eligibility, you must fill in a new application. **This application should be received by the eligibility committee at least 45 days before the end of your provisional eligibility. If not, your eligibility will end at the due date.**
