Extract of the Paratransit eligibility policy

« Provisional eligibility for a maximum of 18 months is granted when the applicant has the potential to learn to use public transit and it is possible to do so in his area, i.e. the public transit system is adequate and the human resources are available to the training. The 18-month period must be used to draw up a transportation program and provide the training, following which the committee will grant general, partial or seasonal eligibility or refuse eligibility, depending on the results of the training.

Provisional eligibility for a maximum of 18 months may also be granted to an applicant with a physical impairment while in rehabilitation. This rehabilitation may have an impact on the severity of his disabilities and/or his ability to use public transit for some or all of his trips. »

Important

If you think that you will still need the paratransit services beyond the 18-month period of your provisional eligibility, you must fill in a new application. This application should be received by the eligibility committee at least 45 days before the end of your provisional eligibility. If not, your eligibility will end at the due date.
